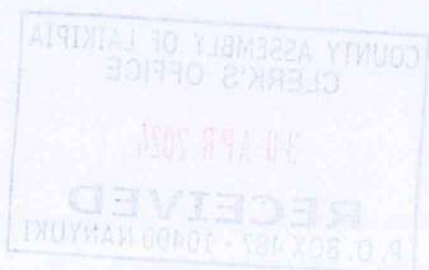

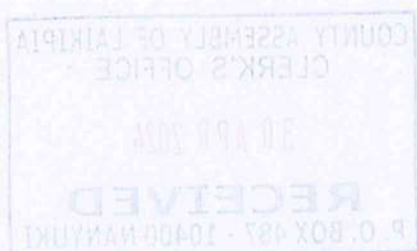

Chapter 1

1.0 : Introduction

Public participation entails a systematic approach to gathering input from individuals, groups, and organizations prior to decision-making. It's important to note that public participation isn't about presenting predetermined decisions but rather about generating and validating decisions. It's not a political exercise but a bipartisan one, where representatives engage with the community to receive guidance and direction.

Laikipia County strides forward in its commitment to inclusive governance, emphasizing transparency and citizen involvement in resource allocation. Central to this ethos is the Programme-Based Budget (PBB) approach, aligning financial resources with the county's development priorities. This report offers an exploration of public participation within Laikipia County's Programme-Based Budget framework. It delves into the strategies, methodologies, and outcomes of engaging citizens in budgetary decision-making, showcasing the pivotal role of community involvement in shaping the county's developmental agenda.

1.1: Legal Basis of Public Participation

Public participation is a constitutional mandate. Article 1 of the Constitution of Kenya states that sovereign power belongs to the people, while Article 10 (2) (a) identifies public participation as a fundamental principle of governance. Moreover, legislative frameworks such as the Public Finance Management Act 2012, Sections 105 and 106 of the County Government Act 2012, and the Laikipia County Public Participation Act, 2014 explicitly outline the necessity of public involvement in both planning and budgeting processes within the county. The PFM Regulations 2015, in section 7, further emphasize the responsibility of County Treasuries to facilitate meaningful public engagement throughout the budgeting process.

1.2: Procedures for Public Participation

PFM Regulations 2015 section 7 states that

- 1) For purposes of public participation in the planning and budgeting process, there shall be participatory structures and processes that shall encompass a broad range of strategies including:
 - Open forums, written submissions, online platform and media
 - Specifications of venues of public participation
 - Dates of public participation
- 2) The CEC member shall notify the general public through a notice in the gazette or at least two newspapers of countywide circulation on the venue and manner of submitting written submissions
- 3) The documents submitted to the county assembly and any other published documents shall be published and publicized within 7 days of presentation.

- 4) The CECM shall give a responsibility statement confirming the extent to which the general public was consulted

1.3: Objectives of Public Participation

The public participation meetings were guided by two objectives namely:

- To educate the public on the county budget process.
- Promote transparency and accountability in budget allocation and expenditure
- Empower citizen engagement and inclusivity by involving them in decision-making processes regarding budget priorities and programs.
- Enhance effectiveness and equity by allocating resources based on community input, thus ensuring equitable distribution and maximizing the impact of budget allocations across all regions and demographic groups.

1.4: Methodology of Public Participation

To realize the set objectives, 64 venues were selected across the 15 wards in the County. Media advertisement was made in the Standard Newspaper dated 8th April 2024. The advert was also popularised through social media platforms.

The public hearings took place from Monday 22nd April to Thursday 25th April 2024 across the sixty four venues in each ward.

The following methodology guided the public participation:

- a. Civic Education on the County budget process.
- b. Presentation of the expected resource envelope.
- c. Receiving contributions and prioritizing projects.
- d. Documentation and capturing of the participants' priorities as guided in the reporting template
- e. Written memorandums were also accepted and were either hand-delivered or sent through the provided email address.

RE: LACCSOF joint Memoranda for the Draft Laikipia County 2024/2025 Fiscal Budget

Laikipia County Civil Society Forum (LACCSOF) is a membership forum of a network of Public Benefit Organizations (PBOs) that are based and working in Laikipia County with the objective of creating synergies for effective delivery of their respective mandates, promoting constitutionalism, creating awareness on civilian oversight, promoting public participation and contributing positively to the development of the county.

We also within ourselves have a network across the county that share ideas and experiences as well as learn from each other in pursuit of each organization individual and shared objectives. This memorandum is merged with the Memoranda developed by the undersigned youths from Laikipia CSO Network, CEDGG, Pathways Policy Institute, Mashinani Youth Network, United Disabled Persons of Laikipia, Institute for Care, Empowerment and Support, Drawing Dreams initiative, Sauti Yangu, and Activista.

As CSOs in Laikipia, together with young people who are committed to supporting the county government of Laikipia to achieve its wider vision of making Laikipia the Greatest County with the Best Quality of Life, we would like to applaud the county government's efforts to spearhead the identification of key pressing needs for the people of Laikipia and work towards enabling every household in the county to lead a prosperous life.

Following the County Government of Laikipia; Department of Finance, Planning and Economic Development call for submission of memoranda on the 2024/2025 Fiscal Budget: We hereby submit our proposals and input to the County Budget estimates 2024-2025 in line with Section 125 (2) of the PFM Act No 18 of 2012.

1. County Administration and Public Service

As an active CSO formation, LACCSOF would like to query the Kshs 500,000 allocated for County CSOs Forum Services under Public Participation and Stakeholders Fora. There has been an allocation in FY2023/24 but LACCSOF is not privy to any CSO engagement with Conty Government of Laikipia within the 2 years. Further, The draft budget for FY2024/25 has Kshs 417,000.

LACCSOF would also like to query Kshs 700,000 allocated for conducting Citizen Score Card Reports. There has been no citizen Scorecard Report publicized for FY2022/23 yet there was an allocation that was also repeated in FY2023/24 and still occurs in the FY2024/25 draft.

There is also the Citizen Annual Engagement Forum under Public Participation and Stakeholders For a with an allocation of Kshs 792,000 in the FY2024/25 draft budget. Over the years, there has not been such fora besides the budget cycle fora.

2. Finance, Economic Planning and County Development

Under the Department of Finance, Economic Planning and Development, LACCSOF would like to query the allocation under Budget Management Services. In the FY2023/24 County Government of Laikipia allocated Kshs 3,000,000 for Budget Unit Operations and Kshs 4,000,000 for Public Participation for

CFSP/PBB. In the draft budget for FY2024/25 there is an allocation of Kshs 3,644,412 and Kshs 240,000 for Public Participation for PBB/CFSP. Why the discrepancy: From Kshs 4,000,000 down to Kshs 240,000? Is the County Government deliberately planning to not conduct Public Participation in the FY2024/25?

3. Health and Sanitation

Under the Department of Health and Sanitation, the FY2023/24 budget had an allocation of Kshs 30,181,720 for Health Infrastructure Development which included construction of 5 new Dispensaries and Establishment of 2 Centres of Excellence. The Draft FY2024/25 budget has an allocation of 48,400,000 for 5 new dispensaries and 1 centre of excellence. LACCSOF suggests that it would be more prudent to equip and staff the already existing ones instead of embarking with construction that will only end up as empty unstaffed and unequipped shells.

Under Health Leadership and Governance the Kshs 500,000 allocated for Meeting the Action Plan requirements for national priority programs (RMNCAH, Nutrition, Community Health, NCDs, Health Promotion and Climate Change adaptation) be increased to Kshs 1,000,000.

Under the Public Health and sanitation; the allocation for Family Planning, Maternal and Child Health Services is Kshs 2,200,000 which considering the population growth, the demand for these services and need to address them is growing exponentially. We recommend adding this allocation to atleast Kshs 4,000,000 to ensure these services are available to all Laikipians.

4. Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries

Under Land and Crop Productivity Management, County Government of Laikipia ought to progressively invest more on this if we are to attain food security in the County. The reduction of Procurement of drought recovery seeds from Kshs 1,000,000 in FY2023/24 to Kshs 850,000 in the draft budget FY2024/25 is an indicator of diverting from prioritizing food security in Laikipia. This is also observed in the reduction of Procurement of Assorted High value fruit seedlings from Kshs 1,000,000 to Kshs 850,000. County Government of Laikipia should deliberately invest in staffing the Agricultural Extension Officers who are already understaffed (or not working) as well as drought resistant crops, pasture and breeding drought resistant livestock.

5. Water and Sanitation

Under Water and Sanitation there is The Locally led Climate change adaptation and mitigation program under which there is an allocation of Kshs 15,000,000 for Desilting Dams for Irrigation. We are of the opinion that this amount should be reallocated to cater for Water harvesting and storage facilities (Gutters and Tanks) in Health facilities across the county. This is because there is already an allocation of Kshs 32,250,000 Under Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries that is allocated for Desilting 15 dams across the 15 wards.

Recommendations

Out of the above highlighted observations, LACCSOF recommends the following:

1. That The allocation for CSO Forum Services be scrapped.
2. That there be an allocation of atleast Kshs 4,000,000 for Civic Education for the Directorate of Public Participation to carry out civic education in the county especially on County Planning and Budgeting Cycle.
3. That funds allocated for Citizen Scorecard be allocated to an independent or non state actor to conduct the scorecard since government technically cannot score itself.
4. That the Kshs 240,000 for Public Participation for PBB/CFSP under Department of Finance, Economic Planning and Development be increased to atleast Kshs 4,000,000 to enable the department carry out public participation effectively.
5. That County Government of Laikipia halts construction of new health facility and scrap Kshs 40,400,000 allocated for construction of new facilities and concentrate on equipping and staffing the existing facilities until they are upto standard and effectively serving Laikipians and only then it shall be prudent to explore into new constructions.
6. That the allocation for Family Planning, Maternal and Child Health Services which is Kshs 2,200,000 be increased to atleast Kshs 4,000,000 to effectively serve the growing population that demands these services.
7. That the Kshs 500,000 allocated for Meeting the Action Plan requirements for national priority programs (RMNCAH, Nutrition, Community Health, NCDs, Health Promotion and Climate Change adaptation) be increased to Kshs 1,000,000.
8. That the of Procurement of drought recovery seeds and Procurement of Assorted High value fruit seedlings be doubled to enable the county make a step towards achieving sustainable food security.

9. That the Locally led Climate change adaptation and mitigation program under which there is an allocation of Kshs 15,000,000 for Desilting Dams for Irrigation be scarpred since there is an allocation of Kshs 32,250,000 for desilting Dams under Agriculture, livestock and Fisheries.
10. That the Kshs 15,000,000 allocated in The Locally led Climate change adaptation and mitigation program be channelled towards water harvesting and storage systems (Gutters and Tanks) in all health facilities in the County.
11. That the Department of Finance, Economic Planning and Development provides LACCSOF with a response to the issues queried in this memoranda as well as a detailed public participation report at the end of the current Laikipia County public participation fora for the draft FY2024/25 fiscal budget.

And that's all we shall pray.
