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Chapter 1

1.0 : Introduction

The County Fiscal Strategy Paper (CFSP) is a document that sets out the policy goals and priorities that will guide budget preparation for the subsequent financial year and the medium term. It gives a comprehensive overview of how the county intends to raise and spend funds within the medium-term expenditure framework.

Public participation provides an all-inclusive avenue where stakeholders and the general public give views on sector priorities to be implemented in the coming year. This process is in line with County Budget Circular 2023/24 released on 30th August 2023.

Laikipia County Government organized public participation meetings on the 2024 CFSP on the 15th and 16th February 2024. Participants were required to give their views on the set departmental ceilings and priorities of each sector. Public views were to be informed by the draft copies of the CFSP that was available on the County Website and a simplified version provided to participants during the meeting.

This report contains public inputs and other remarks on the ceilings and programs for consideration in the financial year 2024/25.

1.1: Legal Basis of Public Participation

Article 201 Constitution 2010, Public Finance Management Act 2012, Sections 105 and 106 of the County Government Act 2012, and the Laikipia County Public Participation Act, 2014 directs on the requirement of public participation across the planning and budgeting processes in the county. The PFM Regulations 2015 section 7 requires the County Treasuries to organize for effective public participation in the budget process.

1.2: Procedures for Public Participation

PFM Regulations 2015 section 7 states that

- 1) For purposes of public participation in the planning and budgeting process, there shall be participatory structures and processes that shall encompass a broad range of strategies including:
 - Open forums, written submissions, online platform and media
 - Specifications of venues of public participation
 - Dates of public participation
- 2) The CEC member shall notify the general public through a notice in the gazette or at least two newspapers of countywide circulation on the venue and manner of submitting written submissions

- 3) The documents submitted to the county assembly and any other published documents shall be published and publicized within 7 days of presentation.
- 4) The CECM shall give a responsibility statement confirming the extent to which the general public was consulted

1.3: Objectives of Public Participation

The public participation meetings were guided by two objectives namely:

- To educate the public on the county budget process.
- To get feedback on the projected resources and the proposed departmental ceilings for the coming financial year.

1.4: Methodology of Public Participation

To realize the set objectives, six venues were selected across the County. Media advertisement was made in the Standard Newspaper dated 1st February 2024. The advert was also popularised through social media platforms and public local gatherings.

The following methodology guided the public participation:

- a Civic Education on the County budget process.
- b. Presentation of the expected resource envelope.
- c. Presentation on the summarized sectors' priorities and proposed ceilings.
- d. Receiving contributions and recommendations on the proposed departmental ceilings.
- e. Documentation and capturing of the participants' priorities as guided in the reporting template
- f. Written memorandums were also accepted and were either hand-delivered or sent through the provided email address.

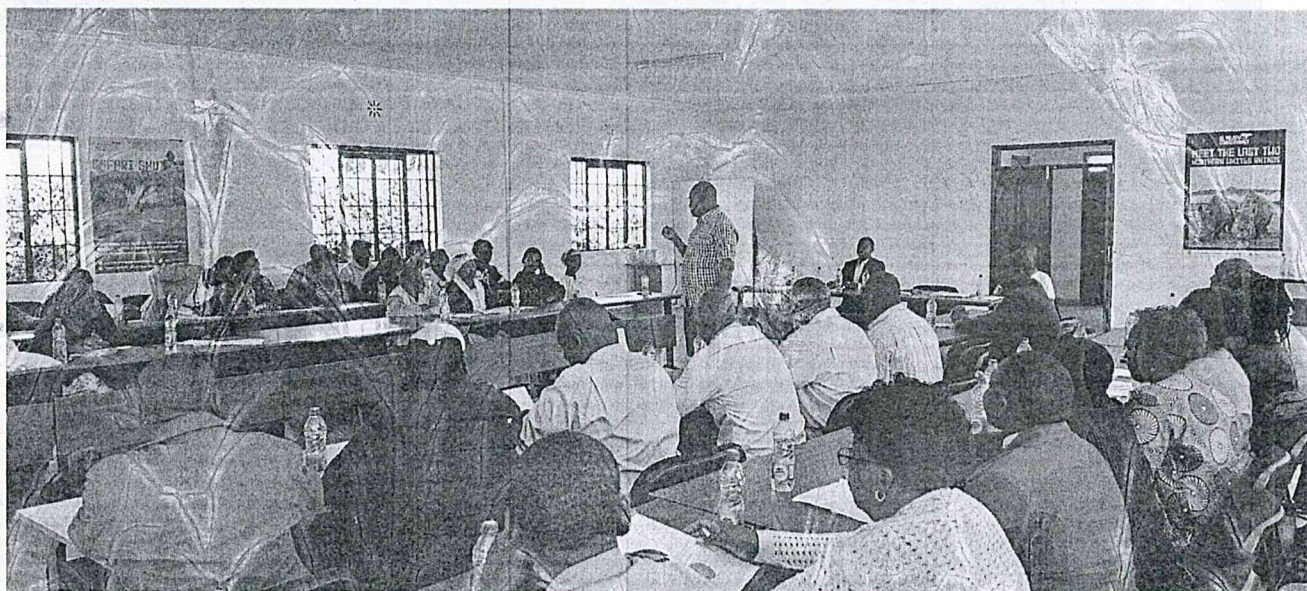

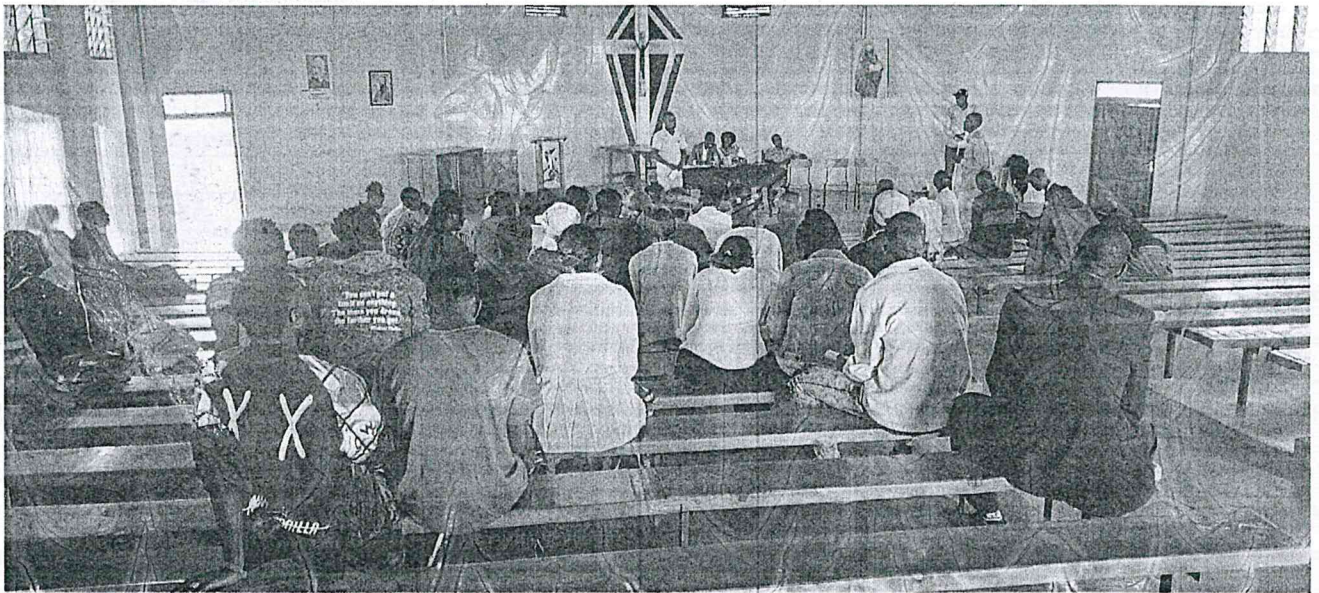

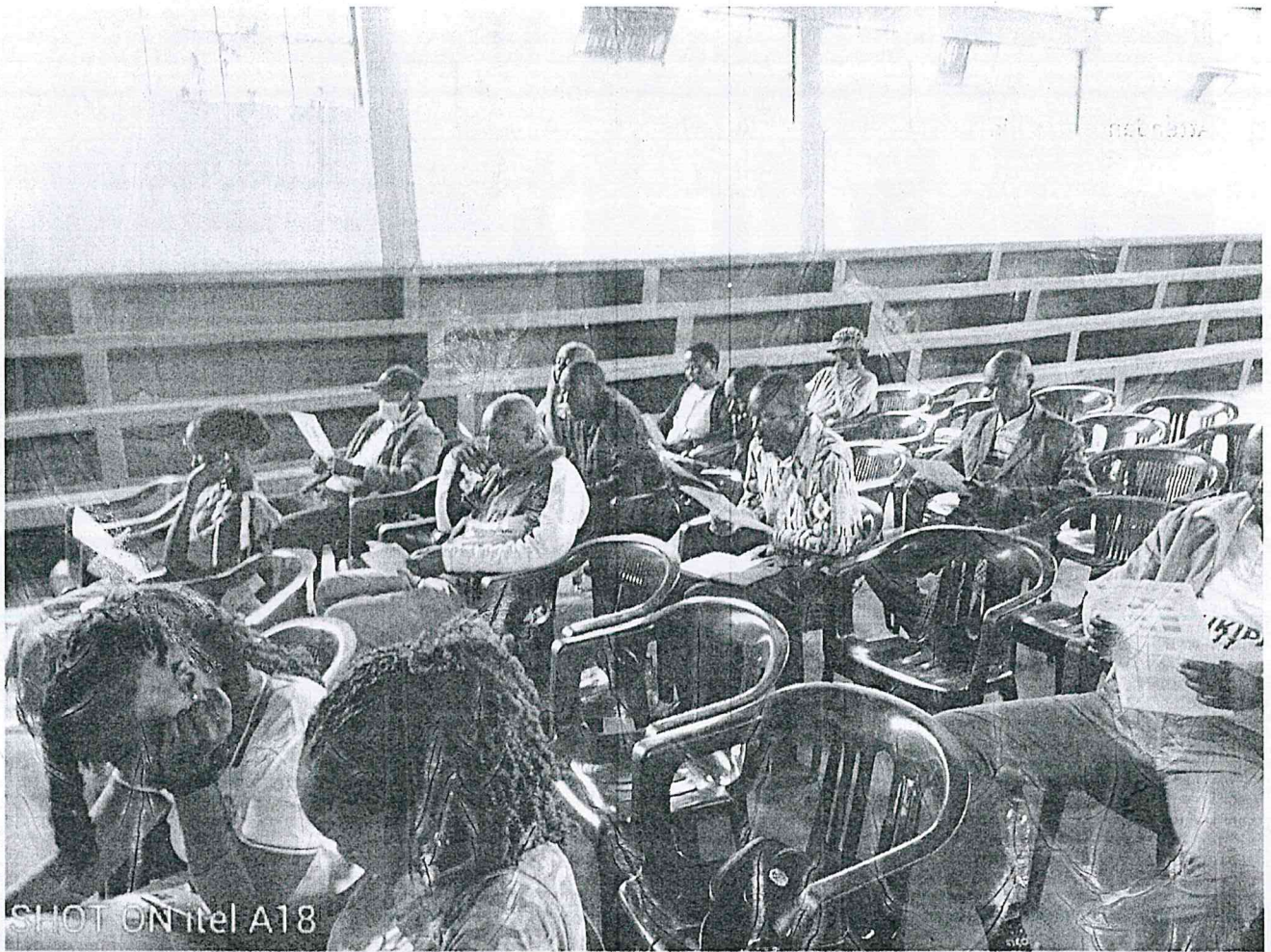
